The procedures were performed in 2-stages. Step 1 was directed at the development of new items and Step 2 intended for testing the psychometric properties of the revised version. As a result of the first step, we selected a set of 38 items. In the second step, the items were tested in a sample of 225 subjects (70.1%females), aged 18 to 66 years (M = 26.2, SD = 8.1), mostly undergraduate students (58.9%). All subjects answered the IDCP, and the Brazilian versions of both, the Revised NEO Personality Inventory (NEO-PI-R) and the Personality Inventory coefficients (Cronbach's ci) of .89 for the total score. The correlations of the Impulsiveness factors with NEO-PI-R and PID-5 revealed consistent and expected relations. The data reveal the adequacy of the revised dimension of IDCP.	Тіро	Periódico
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
