

EDITAL PROEPE 3/2023

SELECTION PROCESS FOR HOSTING FOREIGN PROFESSORS OR RESEARCHERS IN REFUGEE STATUS TO JOIN THE STRICTO SENSU GRADUATE PROGRAMS AT UNIVERSIDADE SÃO FRANCISCO - USF, WITH CAPES SCHOLARSHIP, IN THE FRAMEWORK OF THE EMERGENCY ACADEMIC SOLIDARITY GRADUATE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM.

The Pro-Rector of Teaching, Research and Extension of Universidade São Francisco - USF, in the use of his attributions, hereby decrees the following

EDITAL

Art. 1.º Remain open, from April 4th to May 31st of 2023, the inscriptions of two foreign professors or researchers in refugee status to join the Stricto Sensu Graduate Programs of the Universidade São Francisco - USF, with a scholarship from the Coordination for the Improvement of Higher Education Personnel - CAPES, under the scope of the Academic Solidarity Emergency Graduate Development Program.

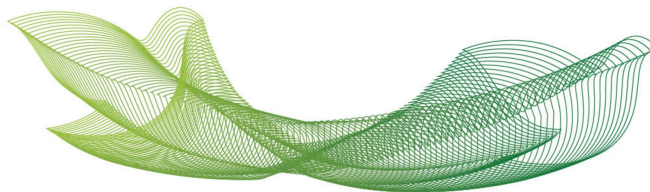
Single paragraph: The Pro-Rector of Teaching, Research and Extension - PROEPE will offer 2 scholarships to work in the following programs:

- I. Stricto Sensu Graduate Program in Health Sciences, Medical area I, Bragança Paulista Campus, São Paulo, Brasil (1 scholarship);
- II. Stricto Sensu Graduate Program in Education, Itatiba Campus, São Paulo, Brasil (1 scholarship).

Art. 2.º The release of the scholarships is conditional exclusively on CAPES' criteria and regulations.

Art. 3.º The requirements for participation are:

- I. To be a foreign lecturer or researcher, in refugee status, who is or has been linked to a teaching or research institution abroad and who presents proven academic-scientific productivity in the areas of Education or Health Sciences;
- II. To hold a doctoral degree, at the time of the grant implementation;
- III. To have a bank account in Brazil;



- IV. To be available to develop teaching or research activities at the Higher Education Institution - HEI that is the project's titleholder;
- V. To establish residence in Brazil during the scholarship period;
- VI. To have a command of, at least, one of the foreign languages: English, French, Spanish, Italian and/or Portuguese;
- VII. To comply with the stipulations of the Term of Commitment, Attachment IV, available at <https://www.gov.br/capes/pt-br/acesso-a-informacao/acoes-e-programas/bolsas/programas-estrategicos/programas-emergenciais/programa-emergencial-de-solidariedade-academica>;
- VIII. To prepare the "Scholarship Recipient Activity Report" (according to the model provided by CAPES), to be submitted within 30 days after the scholarship period ends, and attach it to the Scholarship and Aid Granting System - SCBA.

Single paragraph: It is forbidden for professors or researchers to accumulate scholarships from other CAPES programs or from other federal, state, or municipal funding agencies, except in cases expressly authorized by CAPES' normative act.

Art. 4.º The scholarships granted by CAPES will be paid directly to the beneficiaries through SCBA, <https://scba.capes.gov.br>, in the amount of R\$14,000.00 per month.

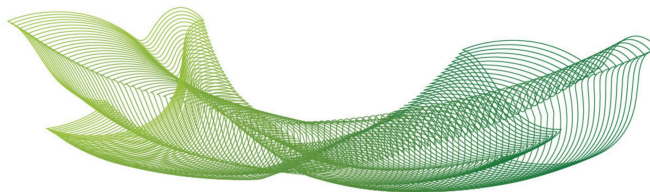
Single paragraph: Each Visiting Professor fellowship in Brazil will have a maximum duration of twenty-four months and the fellow must be accompanied by a Post-Doctoral Fellow.

Art. 5.º The institutional counterpart of Universidade São Francisco will be in the form of:

- I. linguistic support for learning Portuguese - Brazil;
- II. social scholarship/benefit of R\$ 1,000.00 per month;
- III. student housing aid in the amount of R\$1,800.00 per month;

Art. 6.º Registration must be made through the form available at the link <https://docs.google.com/forms/d/1xh0TYEIEE4FRbl2sipsvLN3a7a7MU5oL3kZpwmIOe4o/edit>, and candidates must submit the following scanned documents by May 31, at 11:59 pm:

- I. letter of research intention (maximum 10 pages) written in English, Spanish or Portuguese on the relevance and adherence of the candidate, articulated with the desired Stricto Sensu Graduate Program;
- II. doctoral degree;
- III. curriculum lattes, Orcid or document that proves the researcher's profile and productions;
- IV. passport;
- V. proof of the applicant's relationship with the foreign HEI;
- VI. proof of refugee status, which may be presented:



- a. temporary visa for humanitarian reception (Law No. 13,445/2017 and Decree No. 9,199/2017);
- b. temporary visa or temporary residence permit in Brazil, accompanied by a Refugee Protocol or Provisional National Migratory Registration Document, according to Decrees 9.199/2017 and 9.277/2018; or
- c. Certificate of Confirmation of Refugee Status – <https://help.unhcr.org/brazil/asylum-claim/certidao-de-confirmacao-da-condicao-derefugiado/>;

VII. proof of current address.

Single paragraph: Registrations that do not contain all the required documents will not be carried out, and the candidate will be automatically disqualified.

Art. 7.º The existing vacancies will be filled by the classified candidates in a selection process comprising:

- I. analysis of the documentation submitted;
- II. analysis of the candidate's resume;
- III. interview (eliminary).

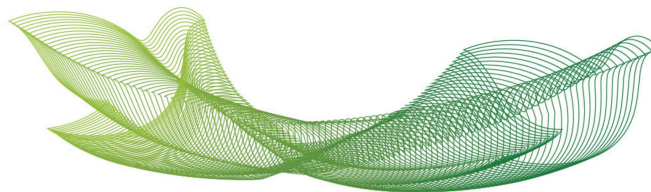
Art. 8.º In the period from June 1st to June 7th, the document analysis and the analysis of the candidate's resume will be performed by the examining commission designated by the Pro-Rector of Teaching, Research and Extension.

Art. 9.º On June 13th, 2023, starting at 2 pm, Brasília time, the interview with the examining board will be held remotely, and the candidates must be available at the link to be forwarded by e-mail.

Art. 10. The result will be available on June 15, 2023, by means of an announcement published on <https://www.usf.edu.br/educacao> and <https://www.usf.edu.br/cienciadasaude>, in the menu information for students / scholarships, with the names of those selected for the call.

Art. 11. The implementation of the scholarships should take place in the beginning of the second semester of 2023 and the candidates should officially manifest themselves within 3 days after receiving the announcement of convocation that will be sent by e-mail.

Art. 12. The rights to participate in the Call, arising from the selection process, are extinguished immediately after its conclusion.



Art. 13. After the announcement of the selected candidates, an appeal may be lodged, with due justification, by means of a request sent to the Stricto Sensu Graduate Center - NPS, to the e-mail address nucleo.pgss@usf.edu.br during the period from June 15th to June 16th, 2023.

Single paragraph: In case of changes upon granting of the appeal, a new announcement will be published.

Art. 14. The present selection process may be suspended or canceled, in whole or in part, due to public interest, legal requirement or CAPES' budget and financial unavailability, respecting the rights acquired, in the form of law.

Art. 15. The Pro-Rector of Teaching, Research and Extension reserves the right, at any time, to request additional information or documents as it deems necessary.

Art. 17. The cases not foreseen in this announcement will be decided by the Pro-Rector of Research, Teaching and Extension of Universidade São Francisco - USF.

Art. 19. The interested parties and whoever may be entitled should be made aware of this so that it may take effect.

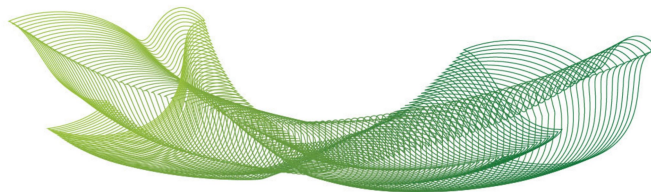
